The process typically goes like this:

- 1. A phone call comes in for assistance on a specific job that needs done.
- 2. An appointment is made to evaluate the project, gather the needed supplies, and perform the work.
- 3. Prayer is offered if there are any needs or concerns.
- 4. Service calls will usually last between 30 minutes and 2 hours, depending on the number and type of jobs being worked on.



5. Homeowners are responsible for the cost of materials, while the labor is provided on a donation basis.
